

Taiwan Public Transport Bicycle Carry Regulations

Taiwan High Speed Rail (HSR)



- Fully Bagged Restriction:
Length $\leq 150\text{cm}$, L+W+H $\leq 220\text{cm}$,
Weight $\leq 40\text{kg}$
- Fee: Free (Treated as general large luggage)
- Placed in luggage area (Do not occupy aisles)

Taiwan Railways Administration (TRA)

A Disassembled & Bagged (Free)



- Standard bicycle carry bag, fully covered
- Size Restriction: L+W+H $\leq 220\text{cm}$
- Placed in designated luggage spaces
- Applicable to all train types

B Travel with Bicycle (Dual-Iron Train)



- Must take specific "Dual-Iron" local trains
- Bicycle half-ticket (Both person and bike need tickets)
- Boarding/alighting restricted to designated stations
- Restricted to front/rear carriages



Long-Distance Bus

A Folding Bicycle (Folded & Bagged)



- Folded and bagged
- Usually free of charge (Depends on bus operator's specific regulations)

B Non-folding Bicycle (Wheels removed & Bagged)



- Remove wheels and bag
- Usually requires a half-ticket purchase
- Placed in the cargo hold

Mass Rapid Transit (MRT)



Taipei Metro (TRTC)



- Weekday Peak Hours (07-09, 17-19):
Bicycle Entry Prohibited
- Holidays/Weekday Off-peak:
Ticketed Walk-in (Both need tickets), Restricted to front/rear carriages



Kaohsiung Metro (KRTC)



Kaohsiung Metro

- Holidays All Day:
➔ Ticketed Walk-in (Both need tickets), Restricted to front/rear carriages
- Weekday Off-peak:
➔ Ticketed Walk-in (Both need tickets), Restricted to front/rear carriages
➔ Specific stations according to KRTC announcement
